

## **Deployment Limiting Medical Conditions**

### **Deployment Limiting Medical Condition 1 (DL1) / Permanent Profiles No Board**

- Soldiers assigned Profile Codes F, V, or X
- Soldiers with a historical permanent PULHES (P3/P4) rating and no evidence of board completion (i.e., assignment of Profile Codes S, W, Y or initial entry waiver T code) and profile is NOT documented in eProfile

### **Deployment Limiting Medical Condition 2 (DL2) / MAR 2 Initiated**

- Soldiers with MAR2 initiated as noted in block 7 of an eProfile created DA Form 3349, but have not completed the board process (profile code "W" not assigned)
- MEDPROS will display how many days Soldier has been in MAR2 process

### **Deployment Limiting Medical Condition 3 (DL3) / MEB Initiated**

- Soldiers with an MEB initiated in block 7 of an eProfile created DA 3349, but not yet completed (Profile Code S or Y\* not assigned)
- MEDPROS will display how many days Soldier has been in MEB process

### **Deployment Limiting Medical Condition 4 (DL4) / Temp Profile Over 30 Days**

- Soldiers with a Temporary (T3/T4) Profile documented in eProfile
- The original duration of the temporary profile is greater than 30 days (this category will NOT include Pregnant females, see next slide for DL5 rating)
- Soldiers in this category who, up until now, were being converted to MR3A when their profile was within 30 days of expiring will now be classified as MR3B until that profile expires

### **Deployment Limiting Medical Condition 5 (DL5) / Pregnancy**

- Soldiers with pregnancy profile documented in eProfile or pregnancy status "Yes" indicated in MEDPROS (*the latter capability being removed as soon as practical once eProfile template mandated use for Pregnancy Profiles*)
- To avoid double counting, these Soldiers will NOT also be rated as DL4 unless they have other PULHES factors supporting a DL4 rating

### **Deployment Limiting Medical Condition 6 (DL6) / Temp Profile Under 30 Days**

- Soldiers with a Temporary Profile (T3/T4) documented in eProfile and
- The original duration of the temporary profile is less than 31 days
- This is the only DL Category where MR 3A is assigned. All other DL categories (1-5) result in assignment of MR3B

# Medical Readiness (MR) Classification

The Medical Readiness (MR) Classification replaced the Fully Medically Ready (FMR) status for the Soldier. The MR Classification provides a more realistic readiness status of the Soldier and their ability to deploy to an austere environment in a timely manner.

» Each Soldier will be assigned a Medical Readiness (MR) Classification. All Soldiers with an MR 1 or 2 will be considered as Medically Available and all Soldiers with an MR 3A, 3B, or 4 will be considered as Medically Non-available. The overall classification will be based on the lowest classification for a Soldier. This will be based on the following criteria:

- » **MR 1 – Meets all Requirements and Dental Readiness Class 1 or 2 (Green)**
- » **MR 2 – Correctable within 72 hours (Amber). Soldier is Deficient in one of the following:**
  - » DNA
  - » HIV
  - » Immunizations (IMM) (Routine Adult Immunization Profile)
  - » Individual Medical Equipment (IME) - (Mask Inserts(1MI), 2 pair eye glasses (2PG), Military Combat Eye Protection Inserts (MCEP-1), Medical Warning Tags (MWT), and Hearing Aid w/Batteries (HAB))
- » **MR 3A - Correctable within 30 Days (Red). Soldier is Deficient in one of the following:**
  - » Dental Readiness Class 3 (ERC3)
  - » Temporary profiles with a 3 or 4 in the PULHES that is less than 31 days- (DL6)
- » **MR 3B - Correctable in more than 30 days (Red). Soldier is Deficient in one of the following:**
  - » Permanent Profile without a completed board and/or Profile Code of "F, X, V" - (DL1)
  - » Permanent Profile with a 3/4 in the PULHES, MAR2 in progress- (DL2)
  - » Permanent Profile with a 3/4 in the PULHES, MEB/PEB in progress – (DL3)
  - » Temporary profile with a 3, 4 in the PULHES that is greater than 30 days – (DL4)
  - » Pregnant – (DL5)
- » **MR 4 – Status is unknown (Red). Soldier is Deficient in one of the following:**
  - » Periodic Health Assessment- (PHA)
  - » Dental Readiness Class 4 (DRC4)

Report definitions

- FD = Admin deceased (Service member deceased) Duration - Permanent
- FM = Admin Missing (Missing in Action or POW) Duration - Permanent
- F5 = Admin Separation (Pending Discharge, Separation, or Retirement) Duration - 90 days
- FT = Admin Temporary (Permanent Change of Station (PCS), Terminal Leave, Absent without Leave, Hospitalization, Medical Hold, Convalescent Leave, Legal action pending) Duration - 90 Days

Name	This is the Soldier's name.
SSN	This is the Soldier's Social Security Number (only the last four digits are displayed).
Rank	This is the Soldier's rank.
Age	This is the Soldier's age as of the deployment date.
Sex	This is the Soldier's sex.
MOS	This is the Soldier's Military Occupational Specialty or Area of Concentration.
CMP	This is the Component the Soldier is in AA = Active Army NG = Army National Guard AR = U.S. Army Reserve O = Other (Civilian, contractor)
UIC	This is the Soldier's Unit Identification Code as recorded in the TAPDB.
Location	This is the Soldier's assignment location/station as recorded in the TAPDB.
MR	MRC - Medical Readiness status based upon the MR indicators shown in column headers of reports (from AR 40-501, Chapter 11-5 - specific subparagraphs show at right of definition). MR1: Soldier is fully medically ready for all MR indicators (11-5a) MR2: Soldier is MR2 when their ONLY MR deficiencies can be resolved within 72 hours (as in during the SRP Process). Those MR deficiencies considered correctable in 72 hours include one or more of the following IMR requirements (DNA, HIV, Immunizations, Individual Medical Equipment) (11-5b) MR3A: Soldier is classified as a DRC 3 for dental and/or has a Deployment Limiting Rating of DL6 for an active Temp (T3/T4) Profile with original duration of less than 31 days (11-5c(1) and (2)) MR3B: Soldier is classified with one or more Deployment Limiting (DL) medical condition ratings of DL1, DL2, DL3, DL4, or DL5 (see those codes below for their definitions) MR4: Soldier is overdue for their next Dental Exam or Periodic Health Assessment (PHA) (and has no active MR3A or 3B factors) (11-5e(2)(a) and (b)) E: Soldier has an MRC Exemption posted (see Exemption Code in far left column) G (Green) Circle = Meets requirement Note: A G for Dental Readiness indicates that a Dental Deferral exists for the Soldier. G* for Current Periodic Health Assessment (PHA) indicates that a PHA Deferral exists for this Soldier. R (Red) Square = Does not meet requirement, and deficiency will take =172 hours to resolve (MR2); up to 30 days to resolve (MR3B) or 230 days to resolve; fields without a current status (blanks) are also calculated as red

DNA	MR Element Definitions for UMR Data Report - If the field is blank for a requirement, the Soldier is current. If there is a date/value/text in the Soldier is delinquent as follows: DNA Sample - N indicates DNA not on file at Armed Forces Institute of Pathology (AFIP)
HIV	HIV Test - Date displayed represents date HIV test was due
IMM	Immunizations - Only for Routine Adult Immunizations - Three letter codes appear for those immunizations the Soldier is overdue: HPA - Hepatitis A HB3 - Hepatitis B INF - Influenza (when in season, 1 Dec - 30 Jun) Tet - Tetanus Diphtheria
IME	Individual Medical Equipment - Three letter codes appear for the equipment the Soldier is missing or not rated for: ZPG - missing one or more pair of required eyeglasses or field is blank 1M1 - missing their mask inserts or field is blank MCEP-1 - missing their military combat eye protection inserts or field is blank HAB - missing their hearing aid w/batteries or field is blank AWT - missing required medical warning tags or field is blank

Perm (DL1)	Soldier has non-deployable Profile Codes assigned or Perm 3 or 4 PULHES serial and no profile in eProfile (see AR 40-501, Table 7-2 for full definitions) F - No assignment or deployment to OCONUS areas where definitive medical care for Soldier's medical condition is not available V - Deployment - This code identifies a Soldier with restrictions on deployment to certain areas X - COAD/COAR - Soldier allowed to continue in the military service with a disease, injury, or medical defect that is below medical retention standards Perm 3 or 4 PULHES factor that is not recorded in a Profile's automated DA3349.

MAR2 (DL2)	Soldier in MAR2 board process, not yet completed - Number shown indicates number of days in MAR2 process (since DA3349 indicating need issued)
MEB (DL3)	Soldier in MEB board process, not yet completed - Number shown indicates number of days in MEB process (since DA3349 indicating need issued)
Temp-30 (DL4)	Temp 3 or 4 PULHE's rating -30 days in duration - date indicates expiration date of existing Temp3/4 profile.
PRG (DL5)	Soldier is Pregnant - date indicates estimated date of confinement
DRG4	Dental Readiness Class 4 - Date represents when Soldier's PHA became overdue
PHA	Periodic Health Assessment - Date represents when Soldier's PHA became overdue

Note: Medical Readiness Indicators shown on this report are used to determine the Medically Ready Classification (MRC) Status displayed in the MRC column as well as the MRC Percentage displayed on the UMR Command Drilldown.
