



Brian Allgood Army Community Hospital Improvements

The Brian Allgood Army Community Hospital is on its last phase of a multi-year facility improvement effort. Over \$90 Million has been spent since 2001, to improve the quality and quantity of services to the only US tertiary care facility in Korea plus another \$18M on equipment and furniture. Much of the patient care spaces have all been completed and primarily what is left are upgrades to administrative spaces - and all of it is going on without any interference or interruption to daily patient care. In February, the BAACH will absorb and accommodate the entire Yongsan Health Clinic for about a year while their facility on Main Post undergoes a major repair and expansion project. In addition to the BAACH and Yongsan Health Clinic, the three dental clinics and veterinary treatment facility on Yongsan will undergo major upgrades this year and next.
